

Conway Christian Preschool Behavior Guidance for PK2-PK4

Behavior guidance can be challenging, but at Conway Christian we strive to use a positive approach. Much grace is given to each student as they learn to follow simple rules and instructions. Conway Christian Preschool does not post visible behavior charts or students names in conjunction with behavior where it is visible to the class.

Our goal when it comes to behavior is to teach students to be respectful, responsible and kind to both fellow students and to teachers, as well as other staff members.

We use these simple rules for preschool students in our classrooms:

1. Obey the teachers.
2. Raise your hand to speak.
3. Raise your hand to get up.
4. Be kind to others.

In order to provide the suitable educational opportunities for all students in the classroom and to enhance the effective moral training of the students, Conway Christian Preschool adheres to the following philosophies:

1. The responsibility and authority to discipline comes from God (Ephesians 6:1)
2. Christian love should be at the heart of all discipline. One side of love is correction, an essential part of the firmness of love. Firmness without love becomes harsh, whereas love without firmness is sentimentality. (Proverbs 3:11-12)

When a student chooses to break a rule, a time out of 2-5 minutes can be used, dependent on age. Removal from the classroom setting may be used if the situation warrants.
