

Behavior Guidance for K3-K4

Behavior guidance is challenging but positive each day. Much grace is given to each student as they learn to follow the simple rules below. The students' names are not visible to the class.

Rules for preschool students:

1. Obey the teacher at all times.
2. Raise your hand to speak.
3. Raise your hand to get up.
4. Be kind to others.

In order to provide the suitable educational opportunities for all students in the classroom and to enhance the effective moral training of the students, Conway Christian Learning Academy (CCLA) adheres to the following philosophies:

1. The responsibility and authority to discipline comes from God. (Ephesians 6:1)
2. Christian love should be at the heart of all discipline. One side of love is correction and chastening, an essential part of the firmness of love. Firmness without love becomes harsh, whereas love without firmness is sentimentality. (Proverbs 3:11-12)

When a student chooses to break a rule, time out of 3-5 minutes will be used. Isolation may be used if a child chooses to verbally or physically hurt others.
